In recent years much of Indiana has experienced increased patterns of sustained dry weather during the growing season. Dry conditions have dramatic effects on turf growth as well as the efficacy of traditional lawn management inputs like feeding, seeding, and undesirable weed suppression products.

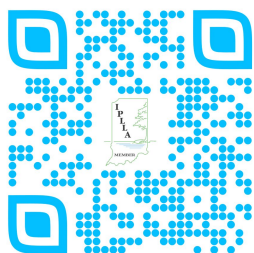
